Band 1

Roschier

What the team is known for Roschier's impressive Nordic platform encompasses its long-heralded Finnish practice and a high-quality team in Sweden. Roschier has a leading presence in the Finnish market, with the Finnish team having been the original foundations of the firm. It maintains a highly impressive reputation in Finland and deeply embedded relationships with large corporations headquartered in Helsinki. It has also carved out a role as one of the leading regional firms in the Nordic countries for cross-border work, also taking on high-profile matters extending well beyond its primary office locations, utilising a network of well-established relationships with 'best friend' firms across different jurisdictions.

The firm acts a trusted adviser to its clients, frequently assisting pan-European and global companies headquartered in Finland and Sweden with outbound business expansion and investment. The Finnish team regularly takes a lead counsel role on pan-Nordic and other multi-jurisdictional matters, teaming up with its Swedish colleagues, and performs strongly across all areas of commercial law within Finland, with a leading reputation in all areas of transactional work, major disputes and areas such as IP, tax and competition law. The team also plays a prominent role on inbound work, acting alongside high-end US, UK and international law firms to coordinate legal advice within the Nordics.

Strengths One source highlights the firm's impressive client base and close ties with international firms: "They have extremely strong links with international firms. They have a really wide spread of clients and they deliver high-

quality work in a timely manner."

Another interviewee notes: "I have enjoyed working with Roschier as our local counsel. I find them commercial, pragmatic and responsive. They would be my first port of call among the Finnish law firms for investment-grade lending work."

Band 2

Borenius

What the team is known for Borenius is a highly regarded Finnish firm with a strong reputation across a full-service range of practice areas. It is highly engaged in international issues, assisting clients through its experience with foreign markets and collaboration with firms overseas and through its own offices abroad. The firm has a presence in St Petersburg and regularly acts for clients on issues crossing Russian and Finnish borders through cross-office teams. The firm also has an office in New York which facilitates Nordic and Finnish companies doing business in the USA or entering that market. Other areas of international activity include a consistent flow of deals in the Nordic and Baltic regions and issues involving China.

Capital markets and banking mandates are particularly active areas of cross-border instruction, with the firm providing Finnish law advice on IPOs, project financing and banking deals across the EU. Cross-border M&A and disputes involving Russia are also a feature of the firm's work while, as a member of the renowned Taxand law firm network, the team is also often engaged on international tax matters.

Strengths The firm attracts a number of plaudits for the quality of its cross-border capital markets work. One source observes: "They are accustomed to working with financial institutions in London and the USA. Members of the team have a very good understanding of US securities legislation."

Another interviewee states: "The firm as a whole is talented, one of the leading firms in the country. They are one of our go-to firms in Finland and we reach out to them on the full spectrum of transactional work."

Castrén & Snellman

What the team is known for One of the leading independent Finnish firms, Castrén & Snellman has a credible track record in international mandates and offers clients a high-quality Finnish practice with experience of collaborating on global matters. The firm's success is largely built on strong relationships with Finnish clients, and the firm is known to guide large domestic companies on dealings with foreign investors or overseas expansion. The firm also acts for inter-

national clients with connections to Finland and is involved in cross-border work as a Finnish counsel, as a popular choice for referrals from high-profile international firms typically from the USA, the UK and other parts of Europe.

The firm's high-quality full-service team means it is a capable partner on cross-border matters across many areas of work including transactions such as leveraged buyouts, financing, M&A and dealing with foreign securities as well as disputes and arbitration. The firm's involvement in pan-Nordic work is often noted, while the practice is also praised for its lawyers' familiarity with Russian law and practice. Recent work has also included assisting Finnish clients in deals with investors from China and India.

What the team is known for Dittmar & Indrenius has impressive experience acting for global clients and international law firms from across Europe and the USA, partnering with them on cross-border instructions involving Finland, for which the firm provides Finnish law input and support. The firm has a longstanding track record of acting for foreign entities in Finland on transactional matters and receives praise for its familiarity with international customs.

The firm's client base includes major regional and global private equity houses as well as corporates that need help with Finnish law aspects of major international M&A and finance transactions, recently acting in conjunction with other leading firms in Europe to advise on financing, structure and execution of inbound investments into large Finnish corporations. The firm also offers strong competition and employment departments which are well placed to advise on all aspects of transactional matters, including cross-border issues relating to merger control procedures.

Strengths "They are my first choice in Finland for sure," says an impressed interviewee, who adds: "I cannot rate them any higher. The company involved could not speak very good English and we could not speak Finnish so they made sure the deal was done."

It is also called upon to coordinate issues related to the Nordic region and other parts of Europe.

With strong departments in M&A, competition law, capital markets and banking, much of the firm's international work revolves around transactions; however, it is also renowned for impressive local law capacity in disputes, energy work, TMT and restructuring. The firm has built a strong following of international clients and actively works for them across practice areas.

What the team is known for White & Case Helsinki is a standout firm among international and domestic firms and is readily marked out as the most prominent international firm in the Finnish market. The firm's appeal covers both the Nordic and global levels and it is renowned for guiding clients through cross-border work. Its well-established office in Helsinki can provide strong coverage across the Nordic states on various transactional matters, together with a similarly strong team in Sweden. Further support from the

firm's global offices, particularly New York and London, makes the practice a popular choice for some of the more complex, high-profile transactions involving English and US law.

Much of the cross-border work undertaken by the firm's Finnish team involves core transactional areas, excelling at capital markets on behalf of banks and private companies. It also has strong expertise in cross-border M&A, finance and private equity deals, where the office advises multinational clients across the Nordics, often being the first port of call on investments into Finland. The firm is consistently praised for having a high-profile international clientele, while it also serves a list of high-profile Finnish companies and banks for pan-European and US-related work.

Clients appreciate the team's top-quality support on international matters with a centre of gravity in Finland, and the firm acts in both lead and local counsel roles for its global clients.

The firm is particularly well geared towards cross-border M&A and financing transactions in the Nordic region on behalf of Finnish-listed companies, Nordic players and global entities. It has an especially thriving inbound practice, including assignments for high-profile names in the private equity, energy and infrastructure sectors. The firm is developing its offering with growing strength across different specialisms, including tax and disputes. It also assists clients with cross-border compliance and risk management.

Strengths Sources underline the firm's robust contacts with practices overseas: "Their network has proven to be valuable in international cases. They have been able to provide us with connections to other local law firms."

Bird & Bird

What the team is known for In accordance with the firm's global mandate, Bird & Bird's Finland practice has a strong focus on acting internationally for clients within regulated industries, particularly the TMT and life sciences sectors. The firm's presence in Finland is largely praised for its cross-border M&A work for businesses in those areas, serving a mixture of local clients growing out and global clients which are represented in conjunction with other offices within the Bird & Bird network. The firm also offers reputable capabilities across disputes, employment law and TMT matters.

The team in Helsinki is particularly active on cross-border issues across the Nordics, offering a useful combination with the firm's presence in Stockholm to handle issues involving Finland and Sweden. The team is also noted for taking lead and local counsel roles in cross-border matters

involving Norway, the Baltic region and the UK, with work typically involving technology platform acquisitions, GDPR compliance and small to mid-market-value M&A deals.

This ensures cross-border and international work is a key part of the team's role in the market, with clients noting good experiences of working with the firm in Finland while collaborating with other offices to cover multiple jurisdictions abroad. Work involving various jurisdictions across Europe, North America and China are all mentioned. The team has also recently led deals focused on the Nordic region, particularly smaller cross-border transactions involving Sweden.

The team in Finland is largely noted for small to mid-sized M&A deals and dispute resolution when it comes to international work, often acting for Finnish companies engaging in deals with foreign investors as well as international clients. The practice also has a good reputation in real estate work and is mentioned for its good work on complex real estate transactions with multi-jurisdictional components.

Band 1
